



Our differences make us unique, But our humanity unites us all. We are all in this together, Let's build a world where love will call.



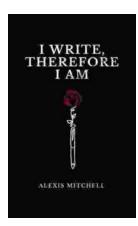
