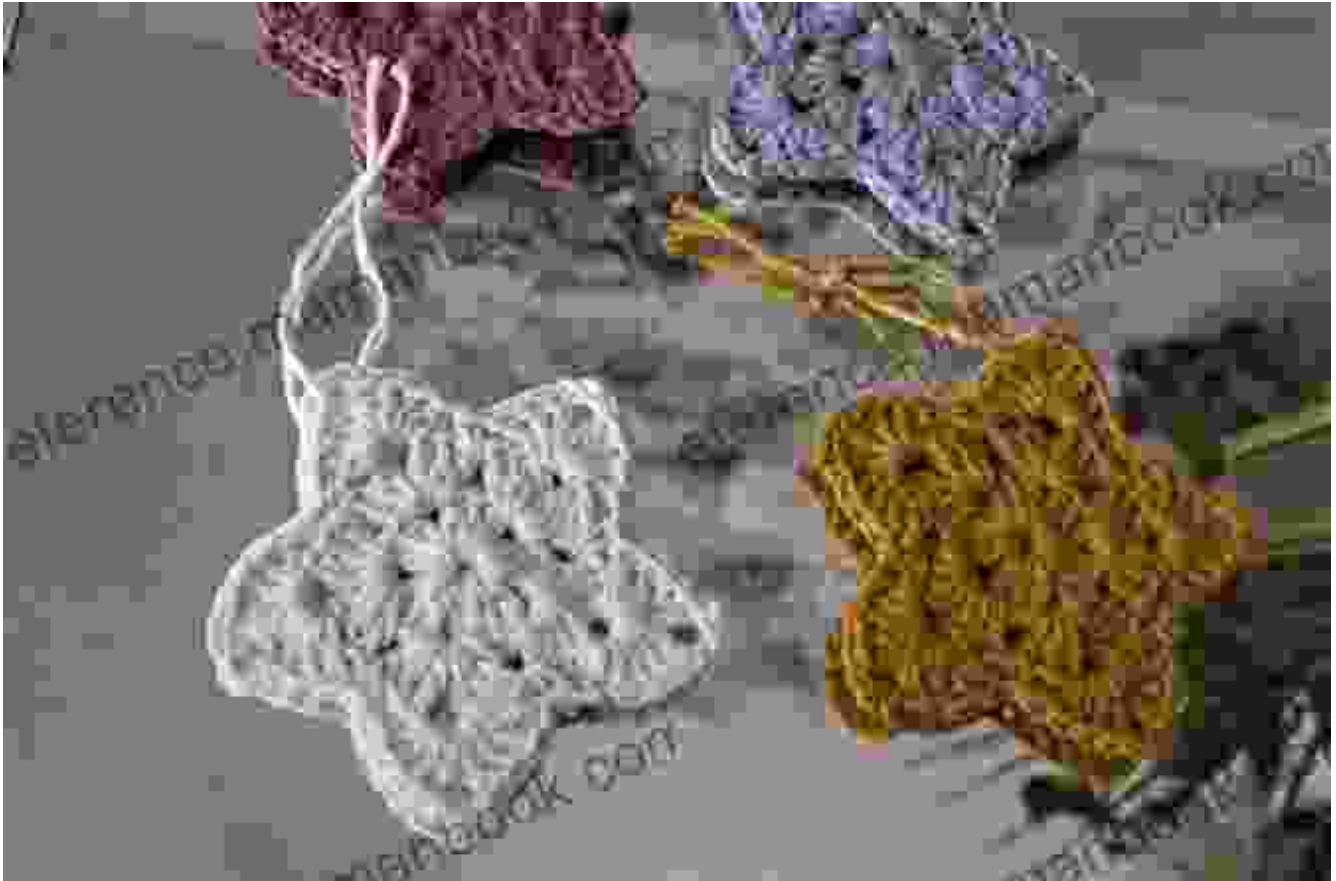

1. Make a magic ring.
2. **Round 1:** Sc 12 in the ring, join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
3. **Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in the next sc, \*ch 1, dc in the next 2 sc\*; repeat from \* to \* 5 more times, join with a sl st to the third ch of the starting ch 3. (6 petals)
4. **Round 3:** Ch 3, dc in the next ch 1 space, \*ch 2, dc in the next ch 1 space\*; repeat from \* to \* 5 more times, join with a sl st to the third ch of the starting ch 3. (6 points)
5. Weave in loose ends and add embellishments as desired.

## Star Ornament



### Pattern:

1. Make a slip knot and chain 5.
2. **Round 1:** Sc in the second ch from the hook, \*sc in the next 3 ch\*; repeat from \* to \* twice more, join with a sl st to the first sc. (5 sc)
3. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in the first sc, \*dc in the next sc, sc in the next 2 sc\*; repeat from \* to \* twice more, join with a sl st to the first sc. (5 points)
4. **Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in all stitches around, join with a sl st. (5 sc)
5. **Round 4:** Ch 1, dc in all stitches around, join with a sl st. (5 dc)
6. Weave in loose ends and add embellishments as desired.

## Bell Ornament



### Pattern:

1. Make a magic ring.
2. **Round 1:** Sc 6 in the ring, join with a sl st to the first sc. (6 sc)
3. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in all stitches around, join with a sl st. (6 sc)
4. **Round 3:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl st. (12 sc)
5. **Round 4-10:** Ch 1, sc in all stitches around, join with a sl st. (12 sc per round)
6. **Round 11:** Sc in the first 3 stitches, hdc in the next 3 stitches, dc in the next 3 stitches, hdc in the next 3 stitches, sc in the last 3 stitches, join with a sl st. (12 stitches)
7. **Round 12:** Ch 1, sc in all stitches around, join with a sl st. (12 sc)

8. Weave in loose ends and add a loop for hanging.

## Tips for Crocheting Ornaments

- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round.
- Count your stitches regularly to ensure accuracy.
- Tighten your stitches evenly to create a firm and durable ornament.
- Experiment with different yarn colors and textures to create unique and personalized decorations.
- Add embellishments such as beads, sequins, or embroidery to enhance the beauty of your ornaments.

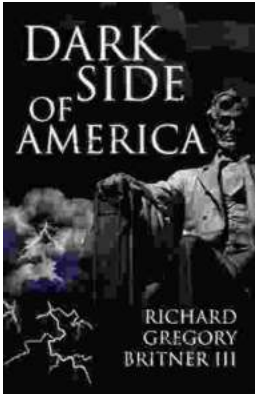

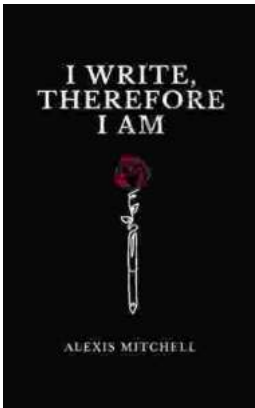
