The children left Lily's garden that day, but they never forgot the lesson she had taught them. They learned that anything is possible if you have patience, perseverance, and self-reliance.

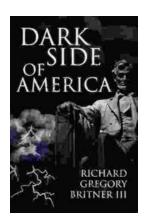

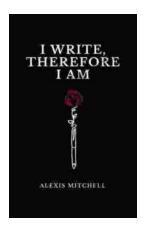
