3. Bind off all stitches.

To make the heel, cast on 12 stitches and knit every row for 2 inches. Bind off all stitches.

To make the toe, cast on 12 stitches and knit every row for 2 inches. Bind off all stitches.

How to Knit Simple Mittens

To knit simple mittens for an 18-inch doll, follow these steps:

1. Cast on 20 stitches.
2. Knit every row for 4 inches.
3. Bind off all stitches.

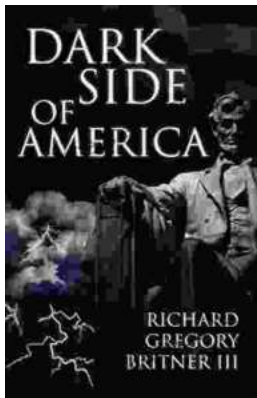

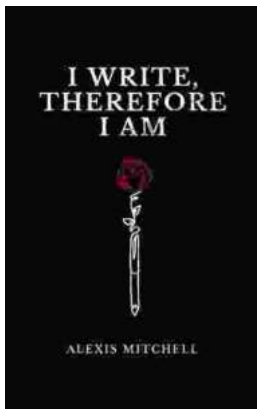
