Transforming into a Chick

To create the chick, start by making a magic ring with the yarn. Sc 6 stitches into the ring. Pull the ring tight to form a circle. Continue crocheting in the round, increasing the number of stitches in each round until you have a total of 18 stitches.

Once you have 18 stitches, continue crocheting without increasing. Change to a contrasting color and crochet 2 rounds in sc. This will create the beak of the chick. For the body of the chick, continue crocheting with the main color. Crochet 4 rounds in sc.

To shape the head, decrease the number of stitches in each round by sc2tog. Continue decreasing until you have 6 stitches remaining. Pull the yarn through the remaining stitches to close the head.

Assembling the Reversible Masterpiece

With both the Easter egg and the chick complete, it's time to assemble them. Insert the chick into the Easter egg. Align the opening of the chick's body with the opening of the egg. Sew the two pieces together using the tapestry needle.

Flip the egg inside out to reveal the chick. You now have a reversible Easter decoration that can be enjoyed from both sides.

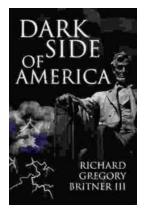
